

Winforton Court

A warm welcome combined with the best of country hospitality awaits you at 16th Century Winforton Court in the beautiful Wye Valley. The village of Winforton has some fine examples of half-timbered or black and white buildings, typical of Herefordshire. It also has a lovely old Church, St Michael and All Angels, which has a half-timbered tower.

Winforton Court was recorded in the Domesday Book, the present House dates from 1500 and is a Grade II Listed Building. Past owners include Roger De Mortimer - one of the earls of March and Henry VIII - when it reverted to the crown. During the 17th Century it was altered to its present 'H' design. It was used as the Court House in the Civil War days and from here the infamous Judge Jeffreys dispensed justice.

There are numerous period features giving all the charm and character of a bygone age but now offering all the comforts expected in the present day. In the front porch, one section has been exposed to show the early 'wattle and daub' infill. The massive studded oak front door was re-cycled from Eardisley Castle. Inside the house is some early stencilling.

Enjoy a hearty breakfast in the former court room, with its magnificent early 17th Century oak staircase and huge stone fireplace.



There is a small library and you may wish to select a good book and sit by the open fire in wintertime in the elegant and spacious guests drawing room, or sit in the delightful gardens with the scent of herbs and flowers in summertime

All bedrooms are beautifully furnished, each with its own distinctive character and charm. Generous hospitality trays with a selection of teas and coffee, fruit juice, bottled water and sherry. All have TV and CD players.

Extra touches include fresh fruit and flowers, hairdryers, travel irons and quality toiletries to add to the comfort of your stay.

All bedrooms have lovely garden and countryside views.

The De-Mortimer Suite has a king size oak four poster, a spacious lounge area with two sofas and a bathroom with a large free standing roll top bath - an ideal choice for a special stay - this suite has magnificent oak timbers and is in the oldest wing of the house.

The Four Poster Room has a lovely Indian style bathroom with ornate carving and again a large roll top bath.

Care has been taken to preserve the character and charm of this ancient building whilst introducing modern day comforts.

Winforton Court has been featured in interior design magazines including "Period House" and "Casa and Country" - a top Italian magazine.

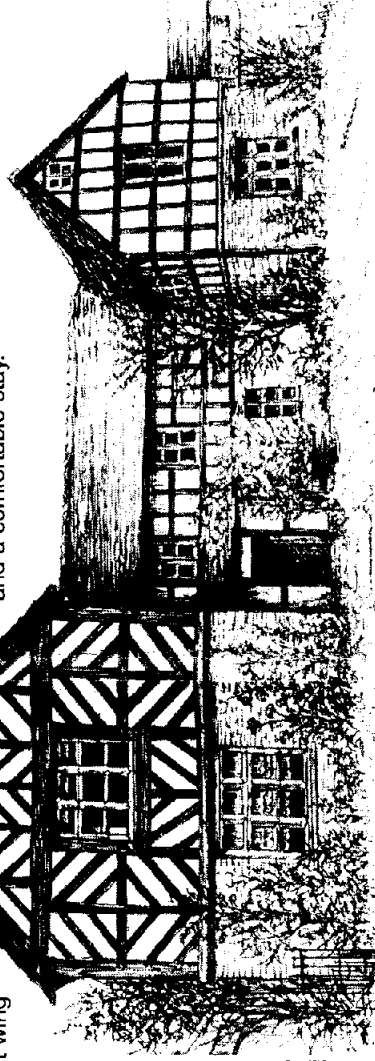
Enjoy a pleasant walk down Bakers Lane to the River Wye - wonderful views and ideal for bird watching.

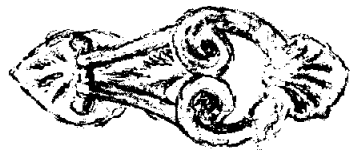

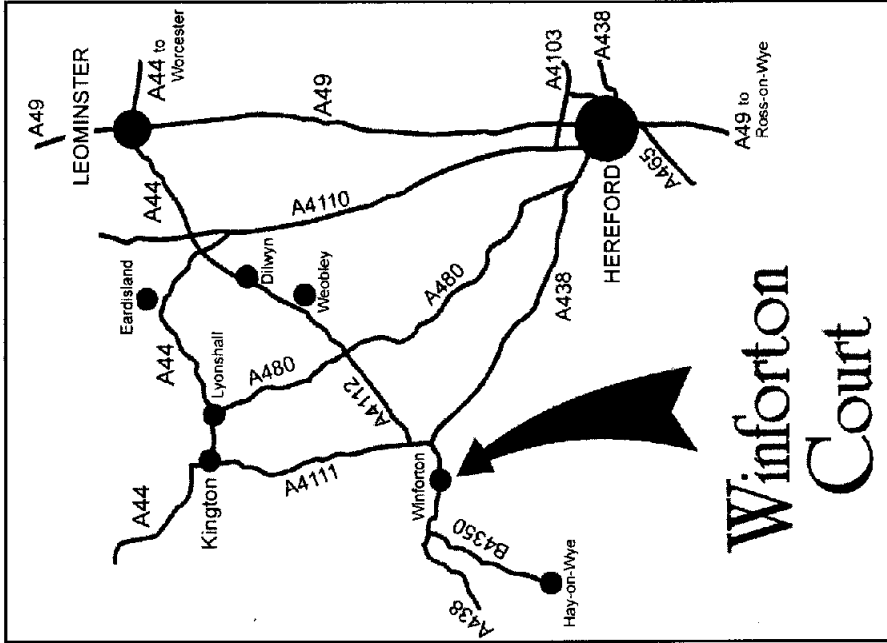

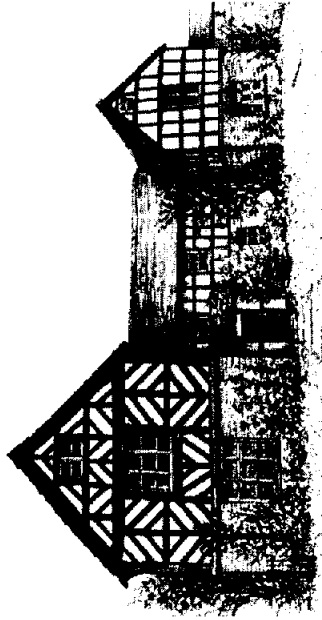
